**Under this agreement for 2018
Parkhurst State School will receive**

\$140,128*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Year Three learners to achieve at and above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading closing the gap from 91.8% in 2017 to 95% by 2019.
- Increase the percentage of ALL learners to 85% achieving a 'C' standard and above in English and Mathematics on end of Semester Report Cards.
- Increase the Upper Three Band (U3B) representation of Year Three and Year Five learners to 60% in Reading, Writing and Numeracy, through targeted and differentiated interventions, including weekly 'Boost Groups', programs and workshops.
- Deliver differentiated Learning Plans for every learner at risk of not achieving a 'C' standard and for those already attaining an 'A' standard in English and Mathematics.

Our initiatives include


- Releasing four Neighbourhood Curriculum Leaders (Mayors) fortnightly to oversee curriculum development, calibrate assessment and support Neighbourhood Teacher Teams to develop as a high performing expert teaching teams.
- Further build staff capacity to deliver quality, high yield pedagogies to embed consistent practices across the school.
- Provide additional casual Teacher Aide support to ensure every P/1 learner has the opportunity to be read to and read to an adult every day.
- Provide onsite coaching, modelling, professional support and feedback to all staff to embed quality reading pedagogies with impact, informed by regular data collections and analysis.
- Supplement the school's Neighbourhood Centre Human Resources to deliver student support services (example Guidance, Students with Disabilities Teacher FTE and Literacy/Numeracy Support).
- State the evidence-base that supports your approach to school improvement.
